

## CODE OF CONDUCT

Georgia USSSA Baseball is the quest in the city that the event is conducted and nothing should occur that would reflect adversely on Managers, Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Trainers, Scorekeepers, Parents, Players, Sponsors, Spectators or Georgia USSSA Baseball. Therefore, it is required that all teams in the event comply with the following:

1. Team Managers shall, at all times, have absolute complete control of their Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Trainers, Scorekeepers, Parents, Players, Sponsors and Spectators both on and off the field as well as in the grandstands.
2. In case of disputed play or decision, Team Managers **ONLY** may consult the game Officials. Other Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Trainers, Scorekeepers, Parents, Players, Sponsors or Spectators are to be kept out of the discussion.
3. Team Managers, Coaches, Assistant Coaches and Players shall not fraternize with Parents, Spectators or Sponsors while on the playing field.
4. At no time shall participants be allowed to smoke or have in their possession any alcoholic beverage while in the dugout, dugout area or on the playing field.
5. Team Managers are to report any Unsportsmanlike Conduct or derogatory acts by other Managers, Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Trainers, Scorekeepers, Parents, Players, Sponsors and Spectators to the Tournament Director. The purpose here is to prevent any serious situation from developing that would be harmful to the event.
6. Team Managers, Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Trainers, Scorekeepers, Parents, Players, Sponsors, Spectators and complete teams are liable for suspension by not adhering to the venue and / or event rules in effect. This could mean suspension for a game, games, event, events or longer depending on the severity of the violation.
7. Team Managers, Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Trainers, Scorekeepers, Parents, Players, Sponsors, Spectators and complete teams may be suspended for fighting, abusive tactics or unbecoming acts that are detrimental and not in the best interest of USSSA Baseball and event play.
8. Be aware of your conduct. Make sure that no actions occur that could reflect adversely on your team or its Team Managers, Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Trainers, Scorekeepers, Parents, Players, Sponsors or Spectators. The wrong actions of one person can reflect upon you, your entire team and the game of baseball.
9. The act of failing to appear for a scheduled game and / or event or withdrawing from an event after the schedule / bracket has been drawn, shall be grounds for immediate suspension from all participation in USSSA.
10. The act of submitting a check non-negotiable at the Payer's Financial Institution shall be grounds for immediate suspension from all participation in USSSA.
